# Supervisory Board process

- “Board of Directors” role model
  - Strategic guidance
  - Hire “chief executive” (CIO)
  - Escalation procedures
  - Oversight through committees
- Management of VITA through “chief executive” (CIO)
- Board intervenes based upon escalation request by CIO

# Major Board accomplishments

- No failed major IT projects
  - ITIB reviews business cases of all projects
  - Improved project management program
    - Qualified project managers
    - Continuous oversight during project execution
- Shifted from technology silos to a common enterprise approach
- Award of infrastructure contract through PPEA process

# Major contract accomplishments

- 21st century technology environment
- Two custom-built, secure data center facilities
- Major information security improvements
- Economic development – New Jobs
- State-of-the-art disaster recovery system
- \$270 million capital investment in Virginia
- Operated within budget for life of contract
  - \$236 million

# Contract issues and actions

- The ITIB is fully engaged in resolving issues in three areas
  1. Complete transformation
    - 6 months to 1 year delay
  2. Operational stability of old technology
  3. Accurate inventory and billing
- Individual teams (6-7) evaluating, addressing and correcting discrepancies
