<a href="#"><u>HB 959</u></a>	Bell	Retail Sales and Use Tax; exemption on certain tangible personal property.
<a href="#"><u>HB 531</u></a>	Cole	Historic rehabilitation tax credit; certain income under federal law is not income for State tax.
<a href="#"><u>HB 1013</u></a>	Comstock	Income tax, state & corporate; extends subtraction for capital gains from investments in businesses.
<a href="#"><u>HB 1148</u></a>	Dudenhefer	Tangible personal property; volunteer deputy sheriffs.
<a href="#"><u>HB 714</u></a>	Kilgore	Major business facility job tax credit; extends credit to December 31, 2014.
<a href="#"><u>HB 922</u></a>	Lingamfelter	Real property tax; exemption for disabled veterans.
<a href="#"><u>HB 277</u></a>	Peace	Cigarette tax stamps, local; same technology used or required by State.
<a href="#"><u>HB 513</u></a>	Purkey	Retail Sales and Use Tax; extends sunset dates for limited exemption periods for certain products.
<a href="#"><u>HB 395</u></a>	Ransone	Line of Duty Act; expeditious payment for burial expense for person whose death is in line of duty.
<a href="#"><u>HB 876</u></a>	Rust	Motor vehicle fuels sales tax; transfer administration and collection to DMV.
<a href="#"><u>HB 299</u></a>	Scott, E.T.	Retail Sales and Use Tax; exemption on certain educational materials.
<a href="#"><u>HB 255</u></a>	Stolle	Warrants; those maintained by treasurers shall not disclose certain information.
<a href="#"><u>HB 406</u></a>	Torian	Incentives, local; local government to provide regulatory flexibility to defense contractors.
<a href="#"><u>HB 202</u></a>	Ward	Hampton, City of; special commissioner to execute title to real estate with delinquent taxes, etc.
<a href="#"><u>HB 154</u></a>	Ware, R.L.	Income tax, corporate; requires retail companies to use single-sales factor apportionment formula.
<a href="#"><u>HB 314</u></a>	Ware, R.L.	Roll-your-own cigarette machines; person who operates at a retail establishment is a manufacturer.
<a href="#"><u>HB 581</u></a>	Watson	Retail Sales and Use Tax; clarifies amount of revenue authorized tourism project is entitled.
<a href="#"><u>HB 117</u></a>	Wilt	Taxes, local; interest on refunds and delinquent taxes.
