<u>HB 52</u>	Albo	Tax information; reports/information provided by Attorney General to tobacco products manufacturer.
<u>HB 624</u>	Albo	Sex offender registry; juvenile registration.
<u>HB 963</u>	Bell, R.B.	Child pornography; possession, distribution, solicitation, etc., penalty.
<u>HB 964</u>	Bell, R.B.	Child pornography or grooming video; displaying to a minor, penalty.
<u>HB 968</u>	Bell, R.B.	Drug trafficking; five years shall be mandatory minimum term of imprisonment for subsequent offense.
<u>HB 973</u>	Bell, R.B.	Sex crimes; penalties for offender who is at least 18.
<u>HB 460</u>	Byron	Income tax, corporate; single sales factor apportionment for income of manufacturers.
<u>HB 752</u>	Cline	Strangulation of another; penalty.
<u>HB 62</u>	Cole	Abortion funding; repealed.
<u>HB 546</u>	Comstock	Gang crimes; includes definition of predicate criminal act.
<u>HB 1134</u>	Cosgrove	Line of Duty Act; definition of deceased person.
<u>HB 1183</u>	Cosgrove	Virginia Port Authority; amends several provisions governing conduct of business.
<u>HB 350</u>	Cox, M.K.	Virginia Retirement System; modifies disability benefits provided to state employees.
<u>HB 508</u>	Garrett	Cannabinoids, synthetic; amends provisions regarding criminalization.
<u>HB 185</u>	Gilbert	Criminal cases; fines and forfeitures collected upon conviction shall be credited to Literary Fund.
<u>HB 1129</u>	Howell, W.J.	Virginia Retirement System; modifies several provisions of defined benefit retirement plan.
<u>HB 1130</u>	Howell, W.J.	Virginia Retirement System; defined benefit retirement program established.
<u>HB 483</u>	Iaquinto	Real property tax; tax concerning validity of valuation of property, etc.

<u>HB 841</u>	James	Major business facility job credits & enterprise zone job creation grants; not allowed for same job.
<u>HB 738</u>	Jones	Human Resource Management, Department of; health and related insurance for state employees.
<u>HB 718</u>	Kilgore	Juveniles; trial as adults.
<u>HB 939</u>	Lingamfelter	Accounts, Department of; recovery of erroneous or improper payments to state officer or employee.
<u>HB 1248</u>	Lingamfelter	Transportation; assignment of general fund revenue, report.
<u>HB 321</u>	Massie	Income tax, state; educational improvement scholarships tax credits.
<u>HB 324</u>	Massie	Tax-supported debt; method of calculating total principal amount issued by any state agency, etc.
<u>HB 207</u>	Miller	Retail Sales and Use Tax; exemption includes gold, silver, and platinum bullion.
<u>HB 536</u>	Orrock	Motor fuels tax; removes requirement that bulk users & retailers of undyed diesel fuel be licensed.
<u>HB 271</u>	Peace	Substance Abuse Recovery Support Services Grant Program; established, report.
<u>HB 274</u>	Peace	Circuit court judges; increases number in Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, decreases in Seventeenth.
<u>HB 29</u>	Putney	Budget Bill.
<u>HB 30</u>	Putney	Budget Bill.
<u>HB 438</u>	Tata	Virginia Retirement System; benefits for certain local law-enforcement employees.
