HB 1816	Kilgore	Methamphetamine manufactory; penalty for allowing child younger than 15 yrs., etc., to be present.
HB 1850	Albo	Assault and battery; adds employees of local or regional corrections facilities.
HB 1927	Morris	Assault and battery; adds volunteer firefighter or any emergency medical service personnel, penalty.
HB 1955	Landes	Impersonating a law-enforcement officer or other public safety personnel; impersonating, penalty.
HB 2211	McClellan	Stalking; Class 6 felony for conviction of second offense within five years of prior conviction.
HB 2235	Lingamfelter	Firearms; increases penalties for use, display, or discharge during commission of certain felonies.
