<u>HB 1716</u>	LeMunyon	Income tax, state; individual subtraction for income attributable to discharge of student loan
<u>HB 1724</u>	Fariss	Forest products; revision of definition, changing of tax on all products
<u>HB 1727</u>	Ware	Commonwealth's tax code; conformity with federal law
<u>HB 1741</u>	Hugo	Income tax; subtraction for long-term capital gains, extends investment period
<u>HB 1843</u>	James	Green job creation tax credit; extends sunset provision
<u>HB 1844</u>	James	Major business facility; job tax credit to spread over two years per qualified full-time employee
<u>HB 1891</u>	Jones	Capital outlay plan; creates a six-year plan

<u>HB 1892</u>	Jones	Commonwealth of Virginia Institutions of Higher Education Bond Act of 2015
<u>HB 2047</u>	Filler-corn	Income tax refunds; voluntary contributions to Hunger Relief Fund
<u>HB 2222</u>	Jones	Commonwealth's Attorneys Training Fund; established
<u>HB 2273</u>	Stolle	Virginia Port Authority; expands police powers
