<u>HB 1152</u>	Morefield	Local gas road improvement and Virginia Coalfield Economic Development Authority tax
<u>HB 1203</u>	Yost	Real property tax; exemption for disabled veterans and spouse of a service member killed in action
<u>HB 1207</u>	Peace	Family and Children's Trust Fund; exempt from taxation
<u>HB 1224</u>	Ware	Bank franchise tax; sets a cap of \$18 million on total annual tax liability per taxpayer
