<u>HB 2365</u>	Knight	Land preservation; special assessment, optional limit on annual increase in assessed value.
<u>HB 2526</u>	Hugo	Income tax, state; changes definition of resident estate or trust.
<u>HB 2555</u>	Pillion	Gas severance tax, local; extends sunset provision.
