Timeline:

- **2015: General Assembly directs Board of Education to redesign School Performance Report Card**
- **2016: School Quality Profiles publicly launched on October 31**
- **2017: School Quality Profiles recognized by National Data Quality Campaign, RVA Tech Council, National School Public Relations Association and Council of Chief State School Officers**

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Additional accreditation reports needed for “dashboard” under revised SOA:

- **“Combined rate” expressing proficiency and growth in English and mathematics**
- **Achievement gaps in English and mathematics**
- **Graduation and school progress**
- **Dropout rates**
- **Chronic absenteeism**
- **College and career readiness**

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New federally required reports under ESSA:

- **Performance of students compared with long-term goals and measurements of interim progress for all students and for student demographic groups**
- **School-level per-pupil expenditure of local, state and federal funds**
- **Number and percentage of English-language learners achieving proficiency in English**

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Budget request:

- **Current FY 2018: \$100,000 (\$48,000 for web hosting and related support)**
- **Supplemental funding for FY 2019 & FY 2020: \$150,000 for each year for creation of new reports and functionalities to reflect revised SOA and comply with new ESSA reporting requirements**
- **Enhancements to improve user experiences, including printing options, downloading of data and accessibility**

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
