



VAFC Member Free Clinics and the Localities They Serve - 2009






VAFC MODEL:

- Lowest cost health care services Model
- Utilize 10,000+ volunteers
- Sixty-Four Percent of volunteers are licensed Professionals
- Create \$5.50 of services for each dollar expended
- We are a provider of last resort for many Virginians

Managing the Surge in Patients:

- Patients are being turned away
- Federal Poverty Level Ceiling Lowered
Family of 3 at 125% = \$22,000
- Waiting lists after qualification - up to 5 months
- Lottery System for Appointments
- Clinics are Overwhelmed



Funding Reduction –Private Sources


- Experiencing decline in local support from private donors
- Local Medical Facilities cutting donated services
- Statewide corporate support has been reduced

Funding from the Commonwealth

- \$1.7 Million – Important and Appreciated
- Expanded clinic hours, new providers , new facilities
- Access Funding reduction to \$850,000 in 2010
