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

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# Who Are Community Health Centers

- 27 Non-Profit Organizations that Operate 101 Health Care Delivery Sites in Virginia
- Provide Comprehensive Primary Care Medical Homes to over 240,000 patients.
- 40% of Patients at a Community Health Center are uninsured, another 30% are Medicaid or Medicare eligible.
- Community health centers employed 1271 FTE positions in 2007.

# Community Health Centers Situation as it Relates to Uninsured Patients

- Centers are Experiencing a Dramatic Increase in the Number of Uninsured Patients.
- Examples:
  - Central Virginia Health Services: 32%
  - Alexandria Neighborhood Health Services: 31%
  - Highland Medical Center: 51%
  - Peninsula Institute for Community Health: 21%
  - Stone Mountain Health Services: 19%

# Community Health Centers Situation as it Relates to Uninsured Patients

- Statewide increase will be approximately **Four-Fold** of past years.
- Most of the Growth in Uninsured Patient Numbers Occurred in the Last 4 Months of 2008.
- Other Payment Systems Remain Flat.
- Local Funding Sources are Experiencing Economic Pressures as Well.
- Operating Funding in the State Budget is Reduced by 50% in FY2010.

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
